Role Title: Vehicle Technician – Commercial Services and Income Generation

Main purpose

Deliver workshop services to internal and external customers as part of a highly effective and professional multi skilled vehicle workshop team. Proactively manage and resolve customer issues through a range of channels.

Key tasks

- Undertake MOT inspections and the inspection of Hackney carriage vehicles
- Inspect the vehicle fleet to DVSA vehicle inspectorate standards and the plant fleet to the standards set by the manufacturers
- To carry out fault diagnosis and associated repairs to the Councils fleet, or on behalf of its clients
- Undertake fabrication and welding on vehicles, plant and equipment, deliver routine plant and vehicle maintenance schedules and carry out road testing of vehicles and plant
- To support the continuous improvement of processes and procedures within the service using best practice from others where appropriate
- Assist with the ordering of materials required for the workshop, in accordance with the Councils Financial rules and Standing orders.
- Assist with delivering appropriate training activities for operatives, in order to develop staff to promote the safe use of plant and machinery.
- Staff are encouraged to participate fully in promoting a safety culture to protect the safety and health of themselves, colleagues and other people affected by the Council's activities
- Support and participate in arrangements and activities to fulfil the Council's Civil Contingency and Emergency Planning Arrangements
